QUEEN'S MEDICAL CENTRE (QMC)

ARRIVING BY TRAIN

The Jubilee campus is 2 miles from Nottingham train station, about a 40 minute walk or a short bus/taxi ride. Due to the distance, we do not recommend walking from the station.

Taking a bus (about 15-20 minutes) - There are a number of bus services from the city centre that drive through or near Jubilee Campus (see overleaf for more info).

Taking a taxi (about 10-15 minutes) - Taxis can be found at the station and throughout the city. DG Cars (0115 950 0500), Cable Cars (0115 922 9229) and the Uber service operate regularly between the city centre and the Jubilee Campus.

DRIVING FROM THE M1

Leave the M1 motorway at Junction 25 to join the A52 to Nottingham.

After 6 miles, cross over the roundabout and pass the Queen's Medical Centre on your right-hand side.

Continue on the A52 towards the city centre for 0.7 miles. At the traffic lights (just after the Rose and Crown pub), turn left on to Triumph Road.

Jubilee Campus starts once you reach the Sir Colin Campbell Building which spans across Triumph Road.

PARKING AT JUBILEE CAMPUS

Visitors to the Jubilee Campus are required to use the pay and display parking facilities.

The pay and display machines accept coins and cards with a full day parking costing £10. Parking charges are in operation from 9.15am to 4.30pm with the first 30 minutes being free.

Parking is also available at the Rose and Crown pub via pay and display. This is charged at £5 per day. The address for the Rose and Crown pub is 500 Derby Rd, Nottingham, **NG7 2GW**.
